Name	2207, 2208 and 2209 by Børge Mogensen.
Description	The armchair and two and three seat sofas are part of a fully upholstered suite designed by Børge Mogensen in 1963. The simple, yet characteristic, design is a continuation of the master, Kaare Klint's, sofas from the 1920s, which inspired details such as the curve in the armrest and the arch of the back.
Construction	Wooden frame, hand upholstered and finished with piping.
Legs	Untreated, clear lacquered or soap treated, or black lacquered oak, or mahogany.
Frame	Wood.
Upholstery	Chromium or vegetable tanned leather from the Fredericia Furniture collection of leathers or fabric upon agreement.
Maintenance	Do not apply stain preventative to any leathers. In case of spots or soiling, clean the entire surface with a ½ dl to 3 litre water soap flakes solution. After cleaning, polish with a soft, dry cloth.
Warranty	Fredericia Furniture A/S guarantees all furniture against manufacturing defects in material and construction for 5 years. Normal wear, tear, and damage to covers and surface finishes are not covered by the warranty.

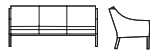
